Faith and Learning in the Lord

I have been blessed to earn degrees from three “church schools,” including two that were established by North Carolina Baptists. While attending undergrad at Wake Forest University, my faith was renewed, my formal study of the Bible and Christianity began. I met and fell in love with Hanna and received my call to ministry. Religion Department professors, many who were ordained Baptist ministers, nurtured my faith and calling, and equipped me for life and ministry. The Baptist Student Union provided me with Christian community. Local Baptist churches gave me opportunities to grow and serve. Out of that time in my life, God called me to ministry. I landed at a second “church school,” Princeton Theological Seminary. Princeton is Presbyterian but also very ecumenical, international, and rigorous. The diverse student body was especially challenging and rewarding. A sturdy foundation was laid for my theological thinking and practice. After serving for seven plus years in the local church, in 2000, I enrolled in the new Gardner-Webb Doctor of Ministry program. I was in the first cohort of students when the program began in the Divinity School. In many ways, I thought earning a D.Min. degree would be “tail feathers” necessary to become a Senior Pastor. However, the Gardner-Webb D.Min. was the most practical, vital study I’ve ever done. I became a much more competent pastor and preacher due to that degree and God’s working through it! I say all this to make one important point: faith and learning are vitally interwoven. Rigorous study is paramount as we seek to better understand our faith in Christ. Baptists have been committed to providing Christian higher education since at least the 1700’s. In NC, we founded seven great institutions. Unfortunately, most of them have become quite secular, including my undergraduate alma mater. However, for those institutions (like Gardner-Webb) that remain committed to faith and learning, these are places where God is at work, revealing ultimate Truth. I’m grateful for my formation in Christian higher education. Let’s continue to look for opportunities to partner with these Baptist schools, helping form young people in the faith and practice of our Lord, and making an impact for Christ in the society at large.

QUALIFICATIONS OF A DEACON

1 Tim 3:8 Deacons should be serious, honest, sober, and unselfish.

1 Tim 3:10 They should have a good reputation and good judgment.

1 Tim 3:12 They should be responsible and Christian in their relationships especially in relation to their children.

1 Tim 3:13 They should serve well, gaining a good reputation for themselves and for the sake of Christ Jesus.

Acts 6:3 These individuals should be full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom; and the congregation is to pray for them.

Eligibility:

- ◆ Nominees must be at least 18 years of age and must have been a member of FBC for at least 2 years.
- ◆ Only one member per household can serve.
Exception: The current household Deacon is rolling off this year.

The Deacon election process is beginning. To qualify, you must be a member of at least 2 years and you must be at least 18 years of age. If you meet these qualifications but do not wish to be considered, please contact the Church Office to have your name removed.

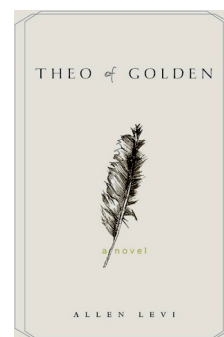
