As Christians, we take seriously the responsibility and privilege of raising our children in the teachings of our Lord. That commitment is actively carried out, in part, through the care and nurture we provide every Sunday morning in FBC's Kid City and the nursery. We are blessed with a thriving, growing Children's Ministry. Alisha Hinson, the Children's Committee, and all the others who make up our leadership team are dedicated and passionate about the Children's Ministry. However, we need more team members. 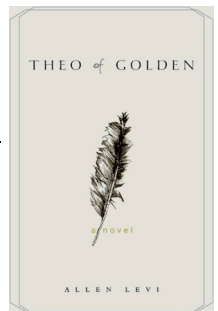

1 Tim 3:13 They should serve well, gaining a good reputation for themselves and for the sake of Christ Jesus.

Acts 6:3 These individuals should be full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom; and the congregation is to pray for them.

Eligibility:

- ◆ Nominees must be at least 18 years of age and must have been a member of FBC for at least 2 years.
- ◆ Only one member per household can serve.
